## Entwicklung



Three girls, all with the chronological age of 13 years, differ dramatically in development according to whether the particular girl had not yet reached puberty, was part of the way through it or had finished her development. This range of variation is completely normal.


Three boys, all of the chronological age of 15 years, show a similar variation in the range of their development. Evidently some boys have entirely finished their growth and sexual maturation before others even begin theirs.
